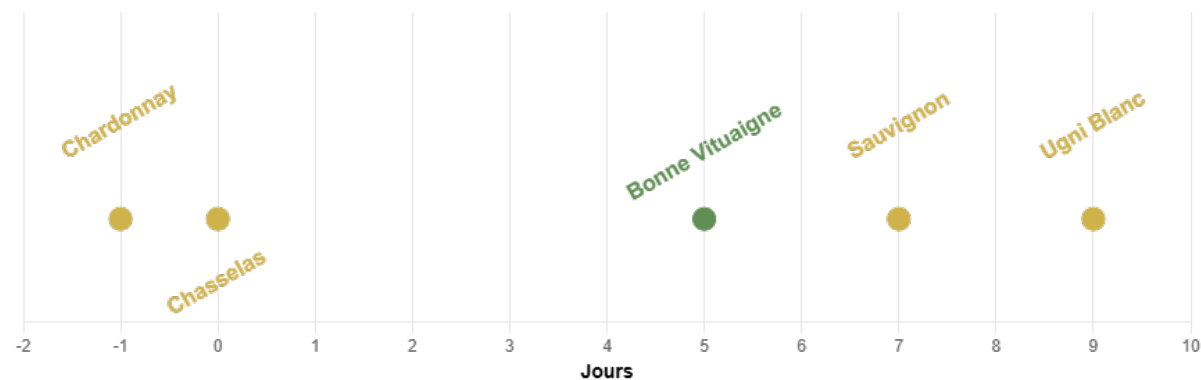
There is no certified clone for this variety yet.

Phenology

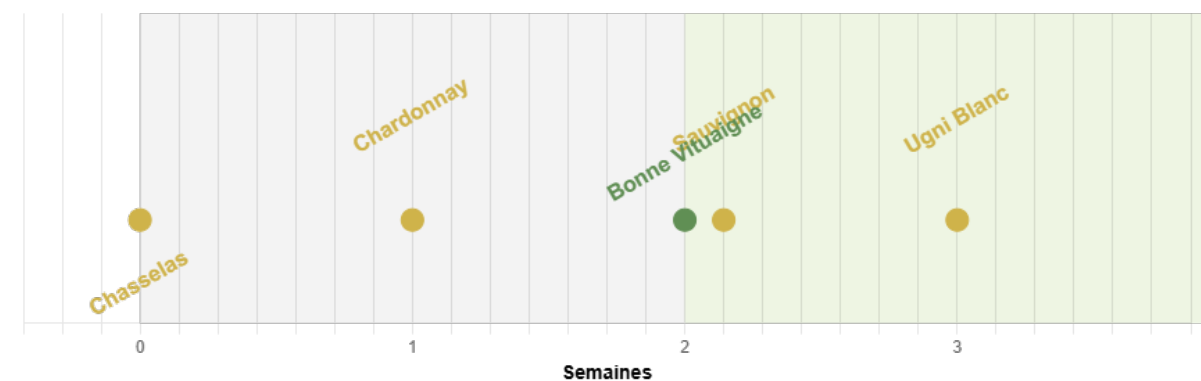
Bud burst: 5 days after Chasselas.
